He has featured regularly as a concert soloist at the Royal Albert and Royal Festival Halls, New York's' Carnegie Hall, Boston's Symphony Hall and the Sydney Opera House.

Leslie Pearson is one of Britain's most distinguished keyboard players. He regularly played at Buckingham Palace for the late Queen Mother and played at HRH Prince Charles' wedding. He was the official keyboard player for the Philharmonic Orchestra for 40 years under Klemperer, Karajan, and Sir Simon Rattle
