Rules and Regulations

The following items are **NOT** allowed on any grave space within the cemetery.

- Grave mound (this does not apply to newly dug graves)
- Items made of glass.
- Ornaments
- Solar Lights/Lanterns (other than ones incorporated within the memorial)
- Wind chimes
- Balloons
- Bird tables
- Items on sticks
- Chippings/pebbles
- Planting
- Items placed on graves which are not secured.
- Edging, kerbs or loose stones (as this makes mowing difficult)

Curry Rivel Parish Council reserve the right to remove, store or dispose of such items without notice to the deed owner.

The main reason for these rules is because they are a hazard when mowing the grass and keeping the cemetery tidy.

Additional information for Lawn Section Graves



At all times there are not to be any items placed on the length of the grave space, all temporary vases are to be kept at the head end of the grave. Once the memorial has been installed there are to be no additional items placed outside of the plinth of the memorial.

Additional information for Crematorium grounds



All temporary vases are to be kept within the area of the slab. Once the memorial has been installed there are to be no additional items placed outside of the foundation base of the memorial.
